



ARTcoWORKers 2 core target groups

- People with disabilities whose freedom rights and lives have been disproportionately affected by the pandemic
- 2. Artists who were deprived of their right to work and their economic perspective during the pandemic





ARTcoWORKers The impact to the core target groups


- People with disabilities have been empowered and qualified to use art and drama for self-expression and to assert equal rights during a pandemic, but also in other situations of discrimination.
- People with disabilities have better and equal access to adult learning opportunities, especially digital learning.
- They got new job and business opportunities





ARTcoWORKers The impact to the stakeholder groups

- The broader local, regional and national public and policy makers are better informed about the CRPD, disability rights in general and during a pandemic and have started to address discrimination and segregation of people with disabilities in institutions and in reduce other facilities.
- The art, culture and creative industries involved find new business and employment opportunities together with people with disabilities.
 People with disabilities get the chance to work as artists in the cultural sector.





- Curriculum
- Training course with 7 modules and sub-modules (course book and booklet with course material)
- Can be used variably by adult educators, artists or people with disabilities as peers
- Gives frames and different starting points depending on previous knowledge
- Recommended for a 7-day training course in the form of blended learning (e-learning and face-to-face units)
- Available in 5 languages

Module 7: Blended Learning, E-Learning

- Shadow theater as an art form is by definition inclusive, in terms of creation and performance, but also in terms of audience consumption.
- Artists perform with their bodies or with puppets. Depending on the selected format and technical equipment, shadows can be projected in front of or behind the screen. Dolls are made by many versatile techniques (and combinations of techniques) manually or with the help of additional equipment and tools.
- Shadow puppets and backdrops look for imperfection in their design and craft this gives them more character and life in the piece.





- A very direct, individually unique and binding connection to the audience is created.
- The clear visual storytelling taps into each person's memories, values and beliefs.
- The multi-sensory experience resonates on so many levels and has the potential to convey crucial messages through a single play.
- Shadow theater demystifies social injustices through the power of mystification, raising important questions and offering tacit solutions.
- Shadow theater promises sensitivity in its approach and offers people with disabilities plenty of safe space for creative exploration and artistic freedom - both in the performers' and audiences' shows.





Main Activities:

- Pilot training of ART coWORKers course as blended learning and e-learning with interactive and transnational sessions,
- Production workshops Consecutive and/or simultaneous 5
 performance processes (1 from each partner) and with different
 content but same methodology.
- Performance performances of the shadow theater plays of all 5 partners, video production, social media appearances,





- The pandemic also impacted the way cultural events are produced, prompting a massive rethink that art forms tend to become more hybrid.
- In the context of shadow theater, the digital production and placement of the shows has a major positive side shadow performances can easily be recorded with a steadycam without losing artistic value.
- With the combined approach of online and offline actions, more audiences can be reached in less time, and the monitoring and evaluation is much more tangible.





ARTcoWORKers The ARTcoWORKers tools

The tool box contains:

- Exchange platform: What creative projects are there? Who offers which project? Are participants wanted?
- Conceptual support: The toolbox also contains a digital project conception aid so that the project management can design the project together with those involved.
- Tutorials: In cooperation with the partners, we develop "how-to" tutorials in the form of videos.
- LAYA: The tutorials are made available on the eLearning platform LAYA

- Learning material excellent for deeper-knowledge, developing time

Work together 2.

- Aspect of training -

How people with disabilities and artists can work together.

- Communication in a group with various disabilities is very challenging. Be honest about it.
- Create an open communication atmosphere, make yourself, as a trainer, first vulnerable.
- Let's build trust: you, as a trainer, have confidence in them that they can do, they can deliver.

- Let the whole group see that you dare to fail and it is not a problem at all.
- Everybody should communicate openly about what she/he likes, does not like/would like to do in another way.

Work together 3.

- Aspect of training -

How people with disabilities and artists can work together.

- Equity in the group gives people independence and trust.
- Also expectation from all members should be equal.
- A common goal motivates the group to move in the same direction.
